



5 reasons why the Jenner Headlands needs to be protected

1. This large, intact coastal landscape is in danger of being carved up and developed into more than 40 home sites.
2. A stunning 2.5 mile segment will be added to the California Coastal Trail so people will be able to enjoy the spectacular Sonoma Coast as they hike.
3. It will provide secure wildlife corridors and habitat to help *all* species adapt to the unpredictable effects of climate change.
4. We will preserve and grow the 3,100-acre redwood and Douglas-fir forest to a healthy old-growth stage for greater carbon sequestration. This project will be one of the first to be registered with the California Climate Action Registry.
5. The clear and clean water will provide refuge for endangered Coho salmon and steelhead.
