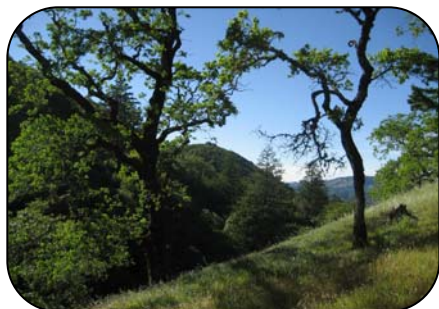

Stewardship Outings - Spring 2009



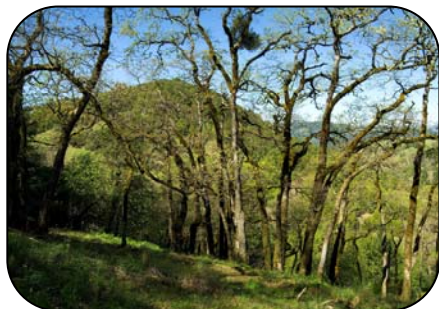
LITTLE BLACK MOUNTAIN PRESERVE WORKDAY Friday May 15th, 10:00am – 3:00pm

Volunteers are needed for a workday at the Little Black Mountain Nature Preserve near Cazadero in west Sonoma County. Come clip and saw Douglas fir seedlings that are encroaching upon the grassland meadows and oak woodlands. Douglas fir seedlings that sprout at the drip-line of oak crowns can eventually shade out the oaks. Workday includes a picnic lunch and hike to scenic lookout.



LAUFENBURG RANCH TRAIL WORKDAY Friday May 29th, 10:00am – 3:00pm

Join a volunteer trail maintenance hike at Sonoma Land Trust's Laufenburg Ranch in Knights Valley. Come explore the historic ranch and help clear encroaching brush from a scenic trail loop. The 176-acre turn-of-the-century farm on Spencer Lane in Knights Valley was bequeathed to Sonoma Land Trust in 1987 by the late Charles Laufenburg.



LITTLE BLACK MOUNTAIN SEEDLING WORKDAY Friday June 5th, 10:00am – 3:00pm

Join Sonoma Land Trust staff for a volunteer workday at the Little Black Mountain Nature Preserve near Cazadero in west Sonoma County. Volunteers are needed to help remove plant protection hardware and help track success rates of native seedlings planted along a tributary of Pole Mountain Creek. A hike to a scenic lookout and picnic lunch will follow workday activities.
